

Title: COVID-19 Temporary Trade Measures – **Tanzania**

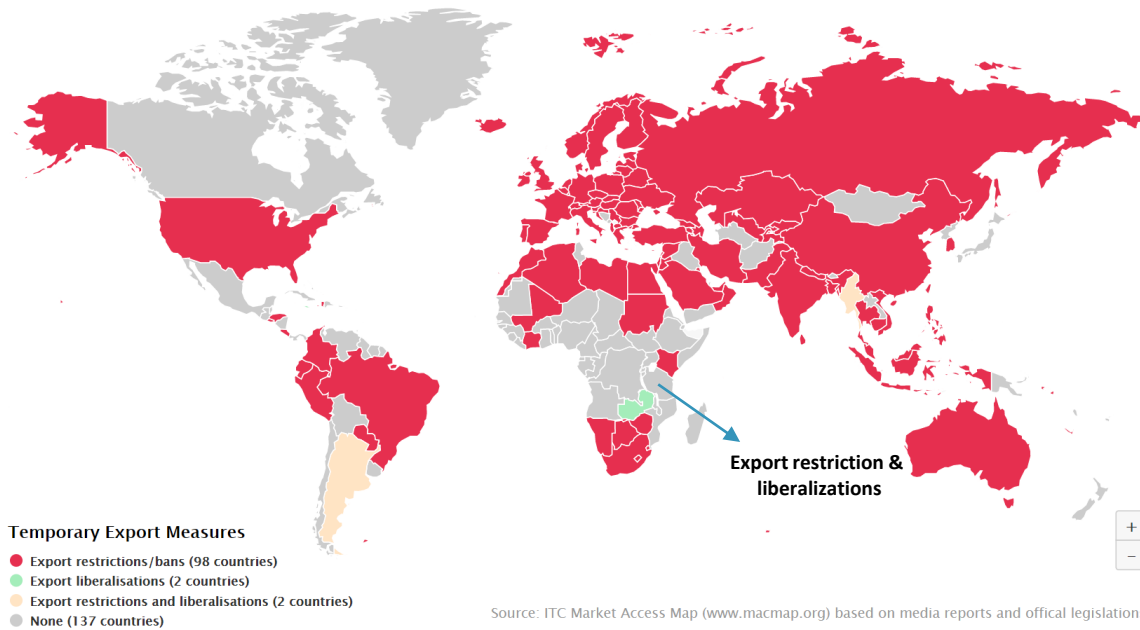

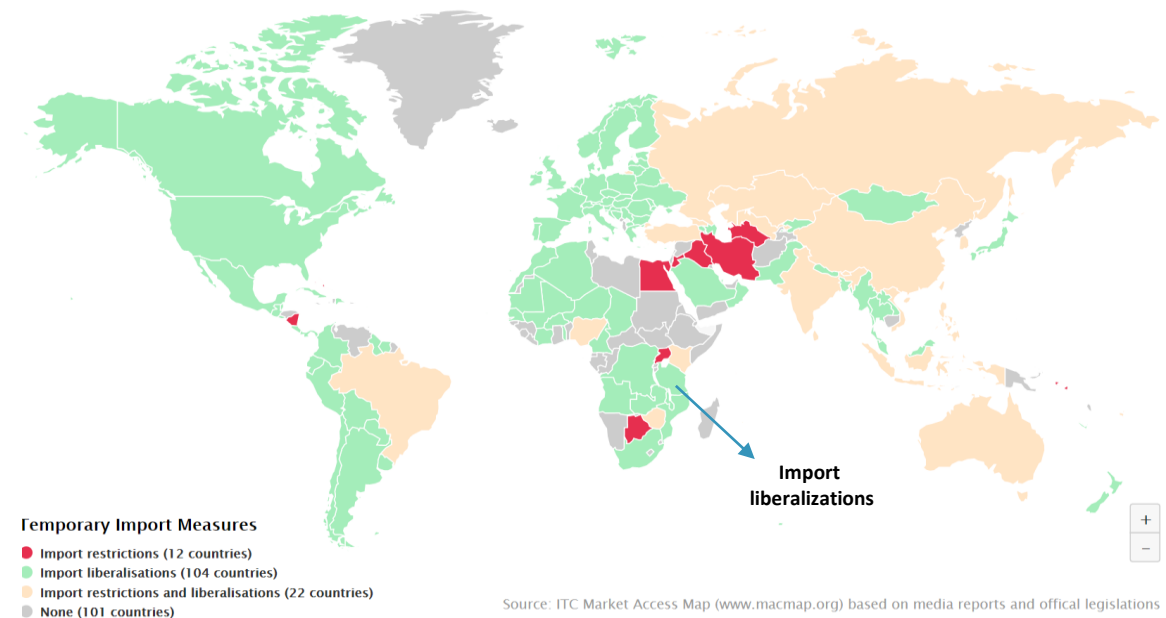
