



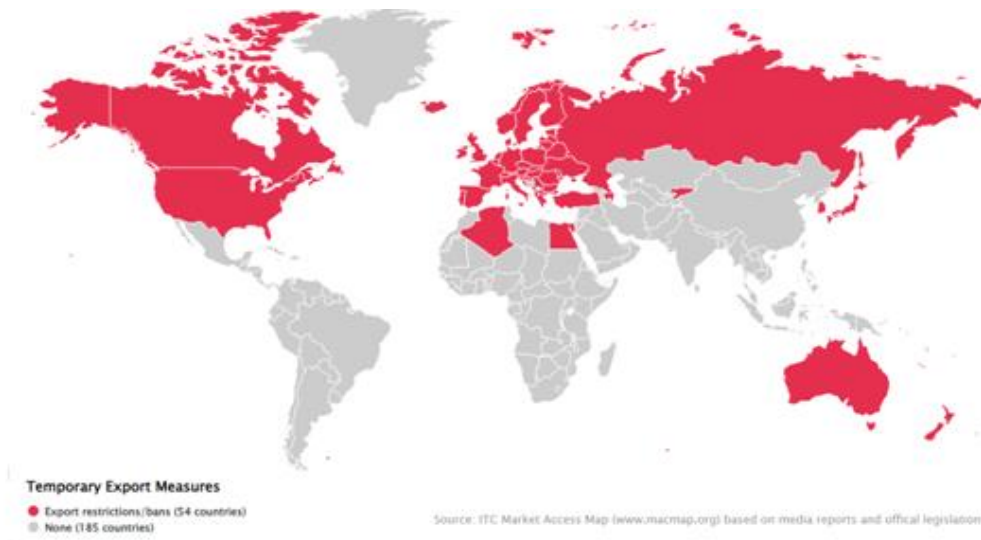

Trade Measures adopted in response to the war in Ukraine

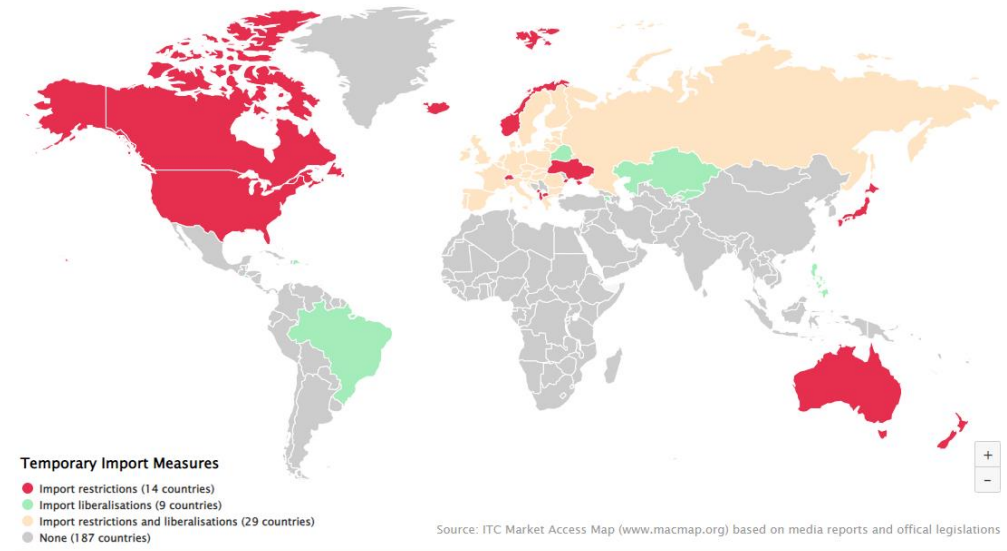

This bulletin shows Trade Measures adopted in response to the war in Ukraine, governments are enacting temporary trade measures as part of economic sanctions and counter-sanctions packages. The rapid destabilization in the region has further led to export restrictions in vital products, such as food and fertilizers, by several countries.

Export prohibition	cereals, wheat, rye, barley, oats, corn, buckwheat, millet, etc.	The Council of Ministers, by resolution No. 125, introduced a temporary ban on exports of certain cereals. The ban is valid for six months.	Restrictive	All countries	Active	13/03/2022	13/09/2022
Export prohibition	buckwheat, cereals, seeds, grains, oxygen	The Council of Ministers, by resolution No. 137, introduced a temporary ban on exports from Belarus, buckwheat, other specified cereals, and oxygen. The ban will last three months.	Restrictive	All countries	Active	16/03/2022	16/06/2022
Export quotas	food products	Belarus limits exports to 1 kg for flour, sugar, salt, pasta, sunflower oil and canned meat, dairy and fish outside of EAEU.	Restrictive	Non-EAEU countries	Active	12/04/2022	Unknown

Export prohibition	rice, pasta, cereals	The government banned the export of rice, pasta, cereals, and flour from rye or barley, as well as certain cereal grains. Restrictions were imposed for three months.	Restrictive	All countries	Active	2022/03/29	2022/06/28
