



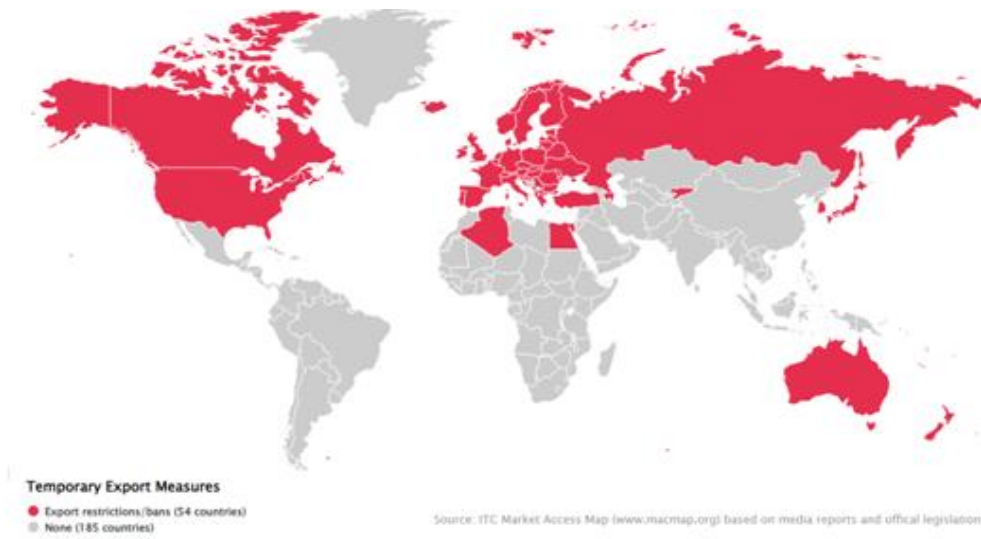

Trade Measures adopted in response to the war in Ukraine

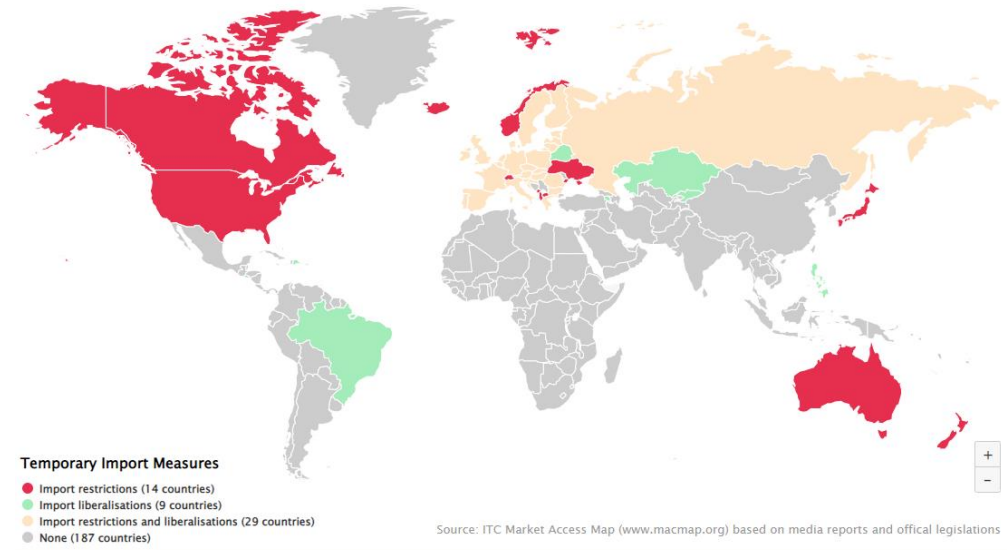
May 2022

This bulletin shows Trade Measures adopted in response to the war in Ukraine, governments are enacting temporary trade measures as part of economic sanctions and counter-sanctions packages. The rapid destabilization in the region has further led to export restrictions in vital products, such as food and fertilizers, by several countries.

Shipment and other formalities	transportation	It is prohibited for any person to dock in Canada or pass through Canada any ship that is registered in Russia or used, leased or chartered, in whole or in part, by or on behalf of or for the benefit of Russia, a person in Russia or a designated person, unless such docking or passage is necessary to safeguard human life or to ensure navigational safety.	Restrictive	Russia	Active	06/03/2022	Unknown
Prohibition for political reasons (embargo)	petroleum oils	It is prohibited for any person in Canada and any Canadian outside Canada to import, purchase or acquire any good referred to in column 1 of Schedule 5 (petroleum oils), wherever situated, from Russia or from any person in Russia.	Restrictive	Russia	Active	10/03/2022	Unknown
Additional tariff	specified goods	Most-Favoured-Nation (MFN) Tariff has been withdrawn from goods that originate in Russia or Belarus. Such goods must now be accounted for under the General Tariff rate of customs duty of 35%	Restrictive	Russia - Belarus	Active	10/03/2022	Unknown
