



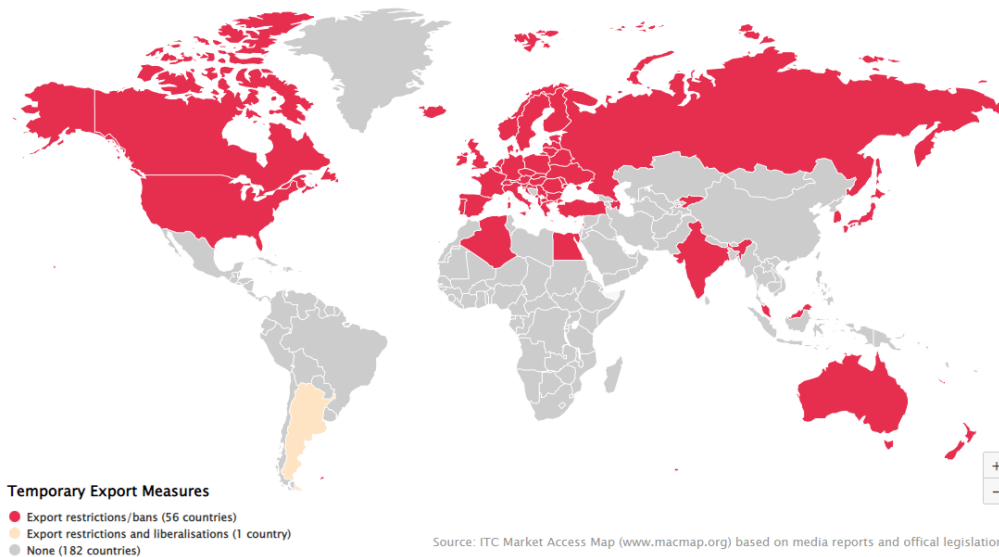

Trade Measures adopted in response to the war in Ukraine

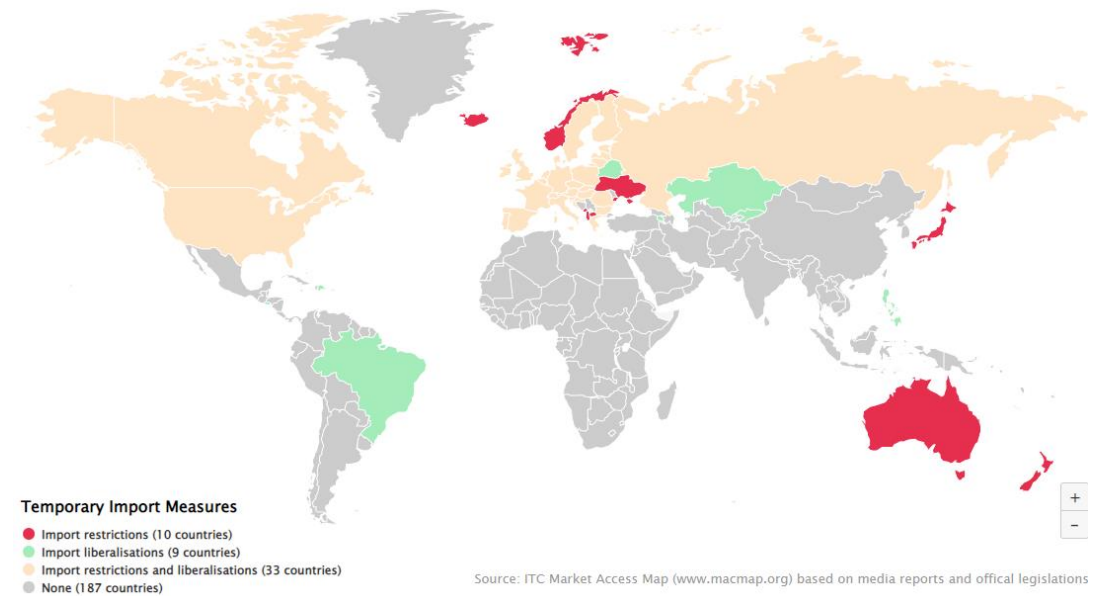

The rapid destabilization in the region has further led to export restrictions in vital products, such as food and fertilizers, by several countries.
