



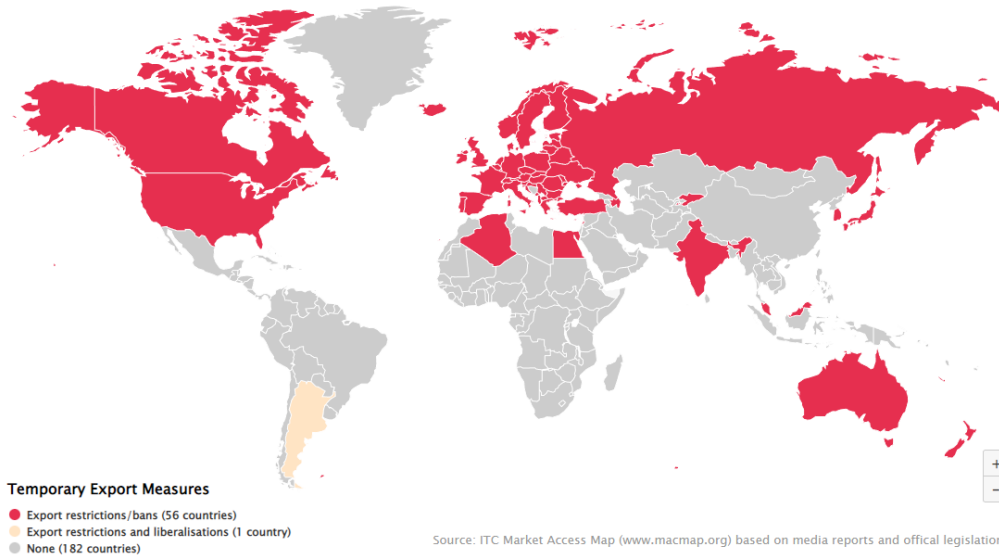

Trade Measures adopted in response to the war in Ukraine

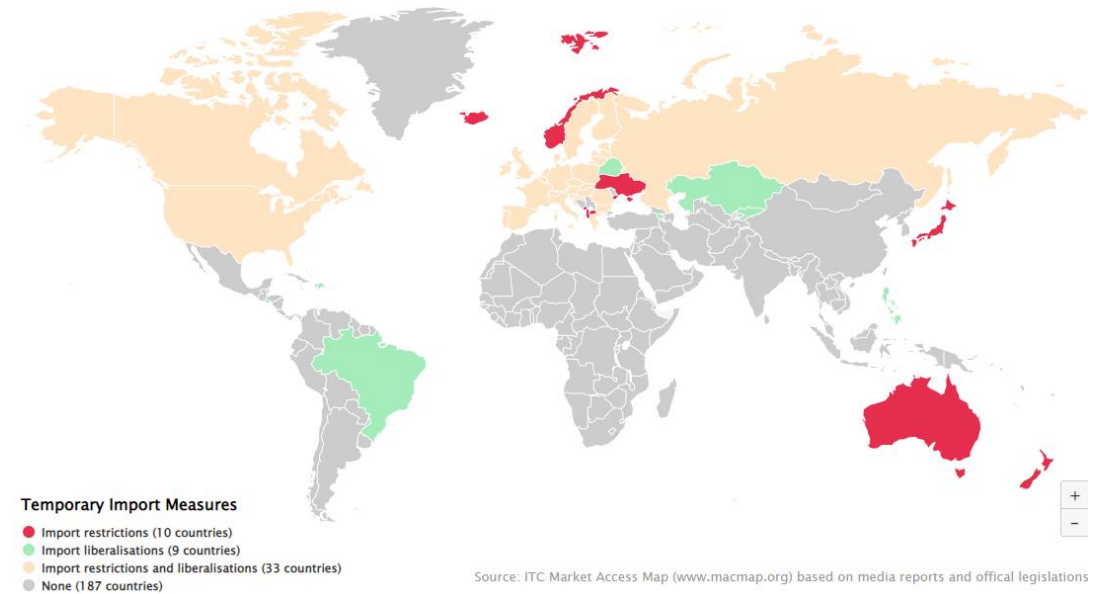

This bulletin shows Trade Measures adopted in response to the war in Ukraine, governments are enacting temporary trade measures as part of economic sanctions and counter-sanctions packages. The rapid destabilization in the region has further led to export restrictions in vital products, such as food and fertilizers, by several countries.

| Export prohibition | military and dual-use goods | March 15, 2022: The measure is extended to Belarus. Exports of additional specified goods are prohibited. February 25, 2022: Export prohibition for military and other goods that have a civilian use but that are intended for military use. | Restrictive | "Russia, Belarus" | Active | 25/02/2022 | Unknown |
| Additional tariff | all products | April 6, 2022: New Zealand will apply tariffs across the board to all Russian imports, entering into force from 25 April. March 8, 2022: the Government passed the Russia Sanctions Act. The intention of the Act is to join the international community in applying tougher sanctions that will limit Russia's ability to finance and equip the war on Ukraine. | Restrictive | Russia | Active | 08/03/2022 | Unknown |
